Dear Dr. Kimball,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your December 16, 2019 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey following up on an initial November 20, 2019 notification by telephone.

According to the information provided, this Office understands that Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey Animal Care and Use Committee (ACUC) determined that instances of noncompliance occurred with respect to: mice bearing tumors that exceeded endpoints specified in the protocol and related IACUC policy. The final report states that it appears the lab waited for Comparative Medicine Resources (CMR) notifications that the endpoints had been met or exceeded to euthanize the mice, despite being counseled multiple times by CMR. It is noted that this research is PHS funded. On July 17, 2019 at its regular meeting, the IACUC reviewed and discussed this incident. The Committee voted to report this matter to OLAW and voted to accept the corrective actions listed below. The corrective actions include the following:

- PI and lab manager were counseled by the IACUC Executive Committee as well as the CMR staff.
- · Lab underwent retraining by the Post Approval Monitor.
- Lab instituted a daily check sheet for tumor monitoring documentation.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey Animal has implemented appropriate measures to correct and prevent recurrences of these problems and is now compliant with provisions of the PHS Policy. We appreciate being informed of these matters and find no cause for further action by this Office.

Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey hereby makes the final report for the following incident, reported to OLAW via telephone on November 20, 2019. On July 17, 2019, the IACUC discussed an incident in which tumors in mice exceeded the endpoints specified in the protocol and the related IACUC policy. It appeared that the lab waited for (Comparative Medicine Resources) CMR notifications that the endpoints had been met or exceeded to euthanize the mice, despite being counseled multiple times by CMR.

The following actions were taken in response to this incident:

- The PI and lab manager were counseled by the IACUC Executive Committee as well as CMR staff.
- The lab underwent re-training by the Post Approval Monitor.
- The lab instituted a daily check sheet for tumor monitoring documentation.
- At its regular meeting on July 17, 2019, the IACUC reviewed and discussed this incident and unanimously voted to report this matter to OLAW. The IACUC also voted to accept the above noted corrective actions.


