Species – Swine (*Sus scrofa*)

Number of animals affected: 10 per protocol = 20 total

(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)

On the first day of surgery, the flap will be harvested from the thigh, and the donor site closed.

(b) (4)

Cage size will be restricted for all immediate post-operative periods to limit movement. We have considered other refinements, but have not found any others to be reasonable to implement. Animals may be housed in pens that are smaller than specified by the Guide in order to limit their movement and facilitate their access to feed and water. This is a noted deviation from the Guide.
