The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your April 16, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Salk Institute. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that newborn pups (mice?) were being decapitated with office scissors and without using anesthesia. This was being conducted in an animal holding room which is contrary to Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) policy.

The corrective actions consisted of retraining the laboratory staff on appropriate euthanasia techniques in rodents and counseling the staff to follow the procedures as described in the approved protocol.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the IACUC to comply with the PHS Policy. Please remember to clearly identify the species involved. Thank you for informing OLAW about this matter.

The Salk Institute, in accordance with the reporting requirements as defined by PHS Policy IV.F.3 and Assurance A3539-01, hereby communicates the following incident of non-compliance that occurred recently.

1) NIH grants AG047669, OD023076 and DK026741

On 3/14/18, a staff researcher was reported to the IACUC for decapitating newborn pups (0-2 days) with office scissors without anesthesia in an animal holding room. After further investigation and review of the protocol, the IACUC concluded that the investigator:

- 1. Conducted an unapproved procedure (decapitation without anesthesia);
- 2. Without proper equipment (sharp scissors or blades);
- 3. In an animal holding room against IACUC policy.

The incident was discussed at a convened IACUC meeting. After reviewing the incident, the committee voted unanimously to:

- 1. Retrain the researcher and the lab on proper euthanasia techniques in rodents;
- 2. Formally remind the entire lab that researchers are expected to follow their IACUC protocol while conducting research.

The researcher as well as all members of the laboratory were retrained and formally advised at a convened laboratory meeting.
