The Allergan Animal Care and Use Committee has approved under protocol 433-100153-2013, Retinal Disease in Primates, an exception to the requirement that primates are to have access to water no less than twice daily for at least 1 hour each time. The exception is required for behavioral studies associated with this protocol. The animals involved received water daily and were monitored according to our water regulation policy. Three of the animals were removed from the study due to reaching one or more of our policies early endpoint criteria. The criteria in place (body score, weight loss, clinical pathology values) are designed to expedite removal of any animals prior to developing any level of distress. The noted animals were returned to the colony with full access to water without incident. All of the remaining animals on study maintained good health and body condition. No animals were determined to be in distress during the study. The total number of animals that were on water regulation for any time during the year was 35. All of the animals were cynomolgus macaques. These animals are included on line 9 of the annual report under category D.
