

Explanation of Animals Listed in Column E

Nonhuman primates

Two (2) nonhuman primates are listed in Category E.

Toxicology Study

Two monkeys were part of a toxicology study evaluating novel compounds. The monkeys were given the compound intravenously. Both animals developed clinical signs including reduced food consumption, reddish discoloration of the skin near the injection site and favored the affected leg. The monkeys were provided with supplemental food (i.e. extra fruit). One of the animals developed an ulcerated lesion over the discolored area. The decision was made to euthanize the animal prior to completion of the study. The second monkey's clinical signs were resolving (i.e. eating normally, not favoring the affected leg, decreased skin discoloration) at the end of the study when the animal was euthanized. Administration of anesthetics, analgesics or sedatives would have confounded the study that was conducted in accordance with US Food and Drug Administration Good Laboratory Practice for Non-Clinical Laboratory Studies, 21 CFR Part 5858.
