Nonhuman primates

Two (2) nonhuman primates are listed in Category E.

Toxicology Study

Two monkeys were part of a toxicology study evaluating novel compounds. The monkeys developed clinical signs including reduced food consumption, vomiting, diarrhea and dehydration. The animals were treated with parenteral fluids. Administration of anesthetics, analgesics or sedatives would have confounded the study that was conducted in accordance with US Food and Drug Administration Good Laboratory Practice for Non-Clinical Laboratory Studies, 21 CFR Part 5858.

Nonhuman primates

Two (2) nonhuman primates are listed in Category E.

Toxicology Study

Two monkeys were part of a toxicology study evaluating novel compounds. The monkeys exhibited decreased food consumption, vomiting and skin abnormalities. The animals were provided with additional fruit and Gatorade®. Administration of anesthetics, analgesics or sedatives would have confounded the study that was conducted in accordance with US Food and Drug Administration Good Laboratory Practice for Non-Clinical Laboratory Studies, 21 CFR Part 5858.
