The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your July 1, 2018 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Drexel University. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that a mouse breeding colony was being maintained although the specific strain was not listed on the approved protocol.

The corrective action consisted of submitting a protocol amendment to the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee, which was subsequently approved.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to correct and prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the IACUC to comply with the PHS Policy.

Dear Dr. Wolff:

Drexel University, in accordance with Assurance A-3222-01 (New D16-00138) and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this report of noncompliance for operating a breeding colony of a mouse strain not listed on an IACUC approved protocol. The work performed on this protocol is supported by National Institute of Heath Grant R21 AR06628.

On 6/13/2018, an Investigator extended a request to the IACUC Administrator for a copy of the approved amendment to add a specific strain of mouse to their approved breeding colony. Upon further investigation, it was discovered that the amendment had not been submitted or approved prior. Within 24 hours of this discovery, the investigator submitted the necessary amendment to the IACUC. The amendment requested less than 10% of the number of animals approved on the original protocol and required no new procedures for colony maintenance. Therefore, in accordance with Drexel's Animal Welfare Assurance, the amendment was able to be categorized as minor and approved by the IACUC chair.

Drexel University is committed to protecting the welfare of animals used in research and appreciates the guidance and assistance provided by OLAW in this regard.
