1) Species: Siberian Hamster

Number of animals used: 445

Exceptions:

- Unrelieved pain or distress
- Single Housing

<u>Justification</u>: The goal of this study is to determine if variation in day length and changes in energy stores influence the body's response to a molecule known as lipopolysaccharide (LPS). LPS is secreted as part of a cell's normal physiological activity. The need to measure food consumption requires that animals be singly-housed.

2) Species: Prairie vole

Number of animals used: 38

Exception:

Prolonged restraint

<u>Justification</u>: Restraint will last 60 minutes and each animal will be exposed only one time. Restraint in this species is a reliable inducer of a stress response without being physically invasive, allowing for the study of social buffering.
