The medical records for three Cynomolgus monkeys on one study documented that they experienced tremors during the study, but no treatment was given for the tremors. The Attending Veterinarian stated that she had discussed the clinical signs with the principal investigator; however, there was no written justification in the study protocol or from the principal investigator stating that treatment should be withheld for scientific reasons. Treatment is required for procedures that cause more than momentary or slight pain or distress to the animals unless the principal investigator documents in writing that withholding treatment is justified for scientific reasons. The IACUC must ensure that activities involving animals are documented in writing for review and approval purposes. TO BE CORRECTED FROM THIS POINT FORWARD.
