#### Evaluation of the Animal Care and Use Program

The IACUC conducted its semiannual evaluation of the institution's animal care and use program on the date shown above using the Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals (Guide), and as applicable, 9 CFR Chapter I, 2.31.
