Animals are given an oral dose of *Clostridium difficile*

Although every effort is made to identify and euthanize animals that become ill following *C. difficile* infection, there are some animals that die naturally very suddenly (presumably because of systemic dissemination of *C. difficile* toxin) without prior evidence of illness or distress, despite frequent observation. Animals will be monitored three times daily for 2 weeks, then daily until the end of the experiment. While some animals with mild symptoms are able to survive challenge with a toxin-variant strain, mortality is an unavoidable endpoint for some animals in these experiments that are designed to investigate the effects of toxin variant strains.
