Dear Mr. Spalding,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your May 4, 2017 letter reporting an instance of noncompliance with the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Pacific BioLabs, following up on an initial report on April 13, 2017. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that five mice were inadvertently assigned to an expired protocol and used on a study. An employee had assigned the mice using the electronic database but failed to confirm that the protocol was still active.

The corrective actions consisted of counseling the individual to use only active protocols, retraining all staff on protocol use, and implementing use of an online list of protocol expiration dates. The protocol was revised and reviewed and approved by the Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee.

Based on its assessment of this explanation, OLAW understands that measures have been implemented to prevent recurrence of this problem. OLAW concurs with the actions taken by the institution to comply with the PHS Policy. Note that if the study in question was supported by PHS/NIH, the funding component also needs to be notified and the activity cannot be charged to the grant. Thank you for keeping OLAW apprised on this matter.

Follow-up Report

Animal Welfare Assurance number: A3363-01

Pacific BioLabs, in accordance with Assurance A3363-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this follow-up report regarding a noncompliance that was reported on April 13, 2017. Specifically, the noncompliance involved five mice that were inadvertently assigned to an expired Animal Care and Use Protocol (ACUP), 17C-05, General Safety Test (Biologics) - Mice. The ACUP expired on 03/26/17 and animals were assigned 3/27/17. The study was completed on 03/29/17. No other animals were assigned to this ACUP after this time.

An investigation was immediately instituted by the IACUC Chair and Attending Veterinarian to determine the root cause of the oversight. The investigation revealed that a staff member had assigned the animals to ACUP17C-05 in the Pacific BioLabs Animal Management System database without confirming with the Study Director that the ACUP was still active.

Toxicology Management immediately counseled the involved employee and reiterated the importance of assuring animals are only assigned to active, IACUC approved ACUPs.

A department-wide training was also conducted by the IACUC Chair regarding ACUPs to ensure all Toxicology staff is clear as to the requirements and regulations involving ACUP assignment and use. Resources included OLAW, the Guide for the Care and Use of Laboratory Animals and the USDA Animal Welfare Act and Animal Welfare Regulations.

Additionally, the IACUC Administrator has developed a centralized, on-line resource easily accessible for all staff to review ACUP expiration dates so that this can be assessed at the time of animal assignment.

Preliminary Report

Animal Welfare Assurance number: A3363-01

Pacific BioLabs, in accordance with Assurance A3363-01 and PHS Policy IV.F.3., provides this preliminary report of noncompliance regarding five mice assigned to an expired animal care and use protocol.

Animal Care and Use Protocol (ACUP) 17C-05 General Safety Test (Biologics) – Mice expired on 03/26/17. Five (5) animals were assigned to this procedure on 03/27/17 and the study was completed on 03/29/17. No other animals were assigned to this ACUP after this time. The non-compliance was noted the week of 04/10/17. The ACUP was reviewed, revised and approved by the IACUC on 04/13/17.

A preliminary assessment of the oversight was conducted and it appears that the assignment of the animals was inadvertently performed by a team member that failed to confirm the expiry date of the ACUP. The IACUC Chair and Committee Members will continue to work to explore areas of improvement in the PBL animal tracking system to prevent a reoccurrence.

We expect to have a complete report within 30 days. A copy of the report will be sent as soon as it is available.
