Dear Dr. Rudolph,

The Office of Laboratory Animal Welfare (OLAW) acknowledges receipt of your September 10, 2018 letter reporting a series adverse events at Colorado State University, following up on an initial September 4, 2018 telephone notification. According to the information provided, OLAW understands that approximately six mice escaped from modified rat cages into adjacent rooms within the animal facility between late 2016 and early 2018. The animal activities in question were supported by PHS funds.

The corrective actions consisted of the IACUC issuing a letter to the Principal Investigator with the requirement that breeding mice be housed in species appropriate caging and reminding him to promptly report adverse events.

The establishment and application of policies and practices that are consistent with the provisions of the PHS Policy on Humane Care and Use of Laboratory Animals at Colorado State University are commendable and avoid the perception of a double standard. We appreciate having been informed about this matter and find no cause for further action by this Office.


