this study involves establishing a dose response curve and a time course of increased
acetylcholinesterase expression following injection of $(b)$ $(4)$ in mice. The
experiments are designed to mimic precisely the conditions of (b) (4)
exposure that humans have and will experience. The investigator is developing a novel
therapeutic procedure for rescuing people from exposure and it is essential to
demonstrate that the (1) (4) can both protect and rescue mammals from
exposure. The (b) (4) would have a different effect on an
anesthetized animal and, more importantly, it would not be possible to visually observe the
endpoint. Unfortunately there are no pre-death endpoints that can reliably predict death from
(b) (4)
