#### ATTENDING VETERINARIAN AND ADEQUATE VETERINARY CARE.

One of the research rabbits had significant malocclusion of the incisors, with both the upper and lower incisors visible when the mouth was closed. The lower incisors were visible for a centimeter out of the mouth and angled towards the right eye, indicating the malocclusion has been present for more than a day, and this condition had not been previously identified by the registrant. The rabbit was still eating and drinking adequately, maintaining body condition and finishing the provided food. The daily care standard operating procedure mentions checking rabbits for evidence of malocclusion, and had not been followed. The registrant needs to communicate with their veterinarian in order to address this health problem.

Daily observation of all animals to assess their well-being, appropriate documentation of those observations, and direct and frequent communication with the attending veterinarian regarding health issues are necessary to ensure that the animals at the facility receive timely and adequate veterinary care. A system should be in place to ensure that all animals are observed daily, any health problems are documented, and the attending veterinarian is notified when necessary.
