The IACUC committee has been fulfilling their responsibilities, but were appointed by the previous CEO. The President of the facility changed and documentation of the appointment of the IACUC by the new CEO/Institutional Official was not available at the time of inspection.

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

Rabbit enclosures measured 30 inches by 36 inches, providing 7.5 square feet of space. Some enclosures were divided by a solid barrier, creating 2 enclosures of 3.75 square feet of space. 27 rabbits, all acquired on 30 November 2017, were housed either as a pair in the undivided enclosure or as a single animal in one half of the divided enclosure. All animals appeared to be approximately the same weight and 3 representative animals were weighed at 9.12-9.2 pounds. Rabbits weighing over 8.8 pounds are required to have 4 square feet of space in order to meet the regulations. Adequate floor space in primary enclosures is essential in order to safeguard the health and well-being of the rabbits. Overcrowding can result in stress, disease, and injury. Primary enclosures should be measured and the rabbits weighed so that rabbits can be redistributed into housing where they have adequate floor space and suitable companions.
