Dr. Gibbens.

I am writing to you today to file an Official Complaint against BTS Research (93-R-0532), for clear violations of the Animal Welfare Act.

As you know, BTS Research was recently cited for what may the crushing/suffocation death of a non-human primate who had become trapped in the squeeze mechanism of a cage which had not been locked down. This citation was issued during a 4-3-19 USDA inspection. The squeezing of this monkey for an extended period (overnight) would have caused extreme pain and discomfort. While the injuries were not disclosed in what must have been a botched post-mortem, they must have been traumatic in nature.

As you also know, BTS Research previously received an Official Warning for improperly confining non-human primates in restraint chairs. This confinement also likely caused extreme discomfort for these animals, and was documented photographically by a USDA inspector. These disturbing photos were obtained by FOIA and are available on the website here: (b) (6), (b) (7)(C), (b) (7)(D) news-media-news-2018/BTS-photos-2-21-18.html

The Official Warning for these previous violations is included in this complaint.

I know that your office considers major violations of the Animal Welfare Act to be very serious in nature. Since BTS Research has demonstrated a history of animal abuse and serious violations, I must insist that you take the most severe action allowable under the Animal Welfare Act and immediately begin the process of issuing the maximum fine allowable against the Oregon State University at the completion of your investigation -- \$10,000 per infraction, per animal.
